

RoosterMoney Skill for Amazon Alexa



Alexa, ask
RoosterMoney...

How to use the 'RoosterMoney' skill for Amazon Alexa:

You can have **"Alexa, ask RoosterMoney..."** about your child's RoosterMoney account, or say **"Alexa, open RoosterMoney"** to have more of a conversation with her.

You can ask Alexa about the following topics:

Balance:

- How much has [child's name] got in total?
- What is [child's name]'s RoosterMoney balance?
- How much has [child's name] got in his/her Spend pot?
- How much does [child's name] have available to spend?

Earning & Spending:

- How much has [child's name] earned this week/month/year?
- How much has [child's name] spent this week/month/year?

Chores: *(Note: Alexa currently only knows what chores your child has to do today)*

- What chores does [child's name] need to do?
- Does [child's name] need to do anything today?
- Has [child's name] got any chores?

How Children can ask questions:

- After they've started with 'Alexa, open RoosterMoney', wait for Alexa's response and say 'I'm [child's name]',
- Alexa will then answer with 'Hello [child's name], how can I help?'
- Your child can then ask the same questions as above by saying, for example, 'How much do I have in my Spend pot?'

Turning RoosterMoney off:

- Simply say 'Cancel' or 'Stop'
